




SAMOC History & Mission

Located in Long Island, NY - less than 1 hour from New York City, - St. Andrew Malankara Orthodox Church (SAMOC) began regular worship services in February 2020.

Our parish belongs to the Malankara Orthodox Syrian Church, which traces her roots back to St. Thomas the Disciple of Jesus Christ.

We are a church rooted in the ancient Orthodox Christian faith, while expressing it in an American cultural context.





Many who were born and raised in the Orthodox Church have stopped being active in their parish communities. Some identified as being jaded, hurt, disconnected to their communities, while others had difficulty connecting to their faith due to a language barrier.



SAMOC is built upon the guiding principle that our ancient Orthodox faith is a treasure to be cherished and valued. We believe that our faith can transform the modern world.




Meeting Worshippers Where They Are


IN PROCESS

We are grateful to our faithful who have offered generously in faith, and the aggressive savings approach the church has taken since its establishment in 2020.





Since its inception, Saint Andrew Malankara Orthodox Church has three primary objectives with regards to its vision and ministry:


